UAF is committed to student success and academic achievement.

General Absences: If you miss class, you are responsible for contacting your instructor concerning your absence, and to discuss the possibility of dropping the class. Some departments drop some classes without approval for the absence.


UAF-Sanctioned Absences: If you are scheduled to miss class in an official capacity (e.g., NCAA), you must notify your instructor in writing by the first Wednesday of the semester in which the absence will occur. The notification must be signed by a UAF school official.

Instructors are encouraged to discuss with students who miss class an official UAF recognized absence. UAF recognizes that students who miss class due to an official absence are still responsible for following up on their course work. Instructors are encouraged to discuss an alternative arrangement for the student's success. If a student misses class due to an official absence, the student should be successful in the class.

Effective: Spring 2017

Rationale: Due to scheduling, the class will be held on Monday instead of a Thursday. This change will require students to notify their instructors of their participation in official UAF-sanctioned activities.
