Requires completion of 15 credits from the following: ASLG F101, ASLG

Proposed Catalog Layout:

1. Complete a minimum of 15 credits from the following classes:
ASLG 101 – American Sign Language I - 3 credits

ASLG 203 – American Sign Language III - 3 credits
ASLG 204 – American Sign Language IV - 3 credits
ASLG 205 – American Sign Language V - 3 credits
ASLG 110 – American Sign Language Practice - 1 credit – Can be repeated for
up to 3 credits

2. Minimum credits required.....15

*Student must earn a C grade or better in each course.

Note: Courses designated as humanities that are taken for the minor may also be used to fulfill humanities distribution requirements for the B.A. degree. Courses that are taken
