

Recommendations for General Education Reform: Proposed new learning outcomes, objectives and instructional goals in four areas

General Education Revitalization Committee (GERC)
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IMPORTANT NOTE: The recommendations contained in this document could lead to significant changes in the ways that UAF students fulfill their General Education Requirements. Changes **could** include converting certain courses (or groups of courses) now required by the Core Curriculum to options that may be applied to new, broader and more flexible learning outcomes. Among the possible changes would be the replacement of O and W requirements with courses from a broader

and inclusive areas such as Civic Engagement and Interpersonal Competence. Understandably, these will be matters of departments, programs and colleges across the UAF campus. The committee has purposely left many aspects of this proposal undefined to inspire lively debate and substantive input among all who are affected by the changes it proposes. Its aim, at this point, is not to propose replacing the current Core Curriculum by fiat, but to initiate a deliberative process for revitalizing general education at UAF.
